

STAKEHOLDER UPDATE NUMBER 5

The Grasmere wind farm is a project being pursued by Verve Energy exploring the feasibility of installing six wind turbines next to the existing Albany wind farm. Since the Albany wind farm was built in 2001, the amount of electricity used in Albany has increased, therefore reducing the proportion of renewable energy used by the City. Through the installation of these six new wind turbines at the proposed Grasmere wind farm, the proportion of locally generated renewable electricity will increase to over 80% of Albany's electricity needs.

This fifth stakeholder update is being made available to people, groups and organisations with an interest in the project.

WIND FARM DISPLAY

To give Albany residents access to more information including the look of the wind farm, environmental issues and community impacts, Verve Energy staff have organised displays at Albany and Elleker in early May. Verve Energy staff will be available at these displays to answer your questions on the proposed wind farm and provide you with additional information on the project.

In Albany, the display will be at the Albany Plaza Shopping Centre, near Kmart, on Friday 2 May and Saturday 3 May from 9am till 4pm. In Elleker, the display will be on Sunday 4 May at the Elleker Hall from 10am till 4pm. We encourage you to attend one of these displays and give feedback on the proposed wind farm.
